A three-time winner of the Pulitzer Prize, Thomas Friedman is the Foreign Affairs columnist for The New York Times. His latest book, "Hot, Flat and Crowded: Why We Need a Green Revolution - and How It Can Renew America," was a *New York Times* best seller. Friedman's other works include "The World is Flat," "Longitudes and Attitudes: The World in the Age of Terrorism," "The Lexus and the Olive Tree" and "From Beirut to Jerusalem."
