
SPRING COMMENCEMENT MAP



Oakland University offers multiple entrances and exits to make your visit to OU safe and convenient. The map above provides a guideline for the best entry and exit routes for you, depending upon your location.

Admission tickets are required for the ceremonies and seating for guests will be available in the Baldwin Pavilion and on the lawn on an unreserved basis. Guests should be informed that this is an outdoor ceremony. Please be prepared for all types of weather if seating in the pavilion is unavailable. Your guests may wish to bring lawn chairs (beach and sand chairs ONLY with short legs and back, 26 in. height maximum) and/or blankets. Balloons are not allowed in the facility.

On commencement day, the pavilion will open for guest seating one hour before the start time of the ceremony. All guests are asked to be seated 10 minutes before the ceremony begins. Note: the gate/turnstiles will temporarily close during the processional (at the beginning of the ceremony) and will open

again for late guests. Children are welcome to attend; however, it is the parents' responsibility to keep them quietly seated during the ceremony, so that the other guests may enjoy the festivities. Each of the ceremonies will be interpreted in American Sign Language for the hearing impaired.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Meadow Brook Road is the most efficient entry from and exit to Adams Road; if possible please use Adams Road.
- The P57 parking lot is handicap accessible parking only.
